

Summary of Revisions to Proposed Language LVTRR Tariff Amendment – August 17, 2006

The additional revisions to proposed CAISO Tariff provisions have been posted as follows: <http://www.caiso.com/1855/185578f652810.pdf>.

For ease of reference, the changes made in the revised version of the proposed CAISO Tariff provisions posted on August 17 compared to the previous versions posted on August 8 and August 15 are shown as additional "redline" with blue shading in the August 17 version. These new changes are summarized below:

- As requested by stakeholders in the August 16 conference call, a new defined term "Non-Load-Serving Participating TO" has been added to simplify the numerous references throughout the proposed new tariff language to such entity. This new term has been inserted in numerous places in the new tariff language. The definition for this term has been adapted from the existing provisions of Sections 6.1 and 10.1 of Schedule 3 of Appendix F, and those provisions have also been modified to use this new defined term.
- As discussed in the August 16 stakeholder conference call, Section 26.1 of the CAISO Tariff and Section 13.4 of Schedule 3 of Appendix F have been clarified to provide that the LVTRR (and applicable Low Voltage Access Charge) of a Non-Load-Serving Participating TO may need to be calculated on an individual facility basis in the event the Non-Load-Serving Participating TO has more than one Low Voltage Transmission Facility connected to different Load-serving Participating TOs.
- In Section 13.1(a) of Schedule 3 of Appendix F, the parenthetical explanation of the components of the Non-Load-Serving Participating TO's LVTRR (which had been copied from Section 6.1(a)) has been deleted -- on the basis that it has no substantive effect and the assertion by stakeholders in the August 16 conference call that it is unlikely to be applicable to a Non-Load-Serving Participating TO in any event.
- Based on comments by stakeholders in the August 16 conference call, Section 13.2 of Schedule 3 of Appendix F has been revised to add a new second paragraph to require a Non-Load-Serving Participating TO to update its Low Voltage Access Charge when the Gross Load of a directly connected Load-serving Participating TO changes pursuant to a FERC order.
