CAISO Control Area Network Model Revision C9 Network Model Implementation

Effective January 17, 2008

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1. Introduction

The mission of the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) is to plan and operate a safe and reliable electric system, facilitate markets for capacity, energy and congestion. But like any organization that maintains reliability, the CAISO must also be a responsive organization that fosters change for the benefit of our customers in California and the West.

The CAISO is prepared to make the modifications to its current Control Area Network Model that are outlined in this document. The proposed changes are scheduled for implementation on January 16, 2008 effective for trade date January 17, 2008.

The following modifications are included in the model:

1. New PGA Resources

This draft proposal will document the modifications in further detail.

2. Summary of Changes Effective for January 17, 2008

The CAISO recognizes any changes to the CAISO Network Model impacts market participants in various ways. To help minimize this impact, the CAISO proposes to implement the changes, as outlined in this document, into one single Network Model release. This approach is expected to reduce the resource requirements and lessen the impact of numerous releases.

The new network model "C9" is scheduled for production release on January 16, 2007 for trade date Thursday, January 17, 2007, HE01.

The C9 model will include two new resources.

2.1 New PGA Resources

The following new entities will be added to the C9 network model. The actual implementation date will be based on the parallel date of the generation resources.
