Reference: Transmission Access Charge Informational Filing

Dear Ms. Sander:

On February 24, 2012, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted an informational filing that provides notice regarding the revised Transmission Access Charges (TAC) effective March 1, 2010, June 1, 2010, September 1, 2010, November 23, 2010, January 1, 2011, February 19, 2011, March 1, 2011, April 20, 2011, July 1, 2011, August 1, 2011 and September 1, 2011. CAISO states the basis for the revisions is to implement revised transmission revenue requirements (TRRs) as reflected in various proceedings for: (1) Southern California Edison Company, (2) San Diego Gas & Electric Company, (3) Pacific Gas and Electric Company, (4) Atlantic Path 15, LLC, and the cities of Vernon, Riverside, Banning, Anaheim, Pasadena, and Azusa, California, in order to implement the initial TRR of Trans Bay Cable LLC and the annual transmission revenue balancing account adjustments of CAISO's participating transmission owners for 2011. Additionally, CAISO states the filing consolidates notice of several revisions to its TAC rates based on a number of Commission orders issued during the past several months that effect TAC rates.

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Receipt of CAISO's informational filing is acknowledged.

This filing was noticed on February 27, 2012, with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before March 16, 2012. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
