Re: California Independent System Operator Corporation Filing to Comply with Order No. 676-I Docket Nos. ER21-2495-000; ER21-2496-001

Dear Secretary Bose:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO")¹

submits this filing in compliance with the Commission's Order on Compliance and

Request for Waivers², issued March 7, 2022. In Order No. 676-I³, the

Commission directed public utilities, including the CAISO, to incorporate into their

jurisdictional tariffs the latest versions of the business practice standards

promulgated by the Wholesale Electric Quadrant ("WEQ") of the North American

Energy Standards Board ("NAESB") and included by reference in the

Commission's regulations.

The CAISO filed for waiver of certain of these standards, which the Commission granted in its Waiver Order. As part of that order, the Commission directed the CAISO to make a compliance filing, within 30 days of the date of the order, to revise section 7.3.3 of its tariff to indicate those Business Practice Standards for which the Commission has granted waiver, and for each of those Business Practice Standards granted waiver, to include a citation to the order granting the request for waivers.⁴

The CAISO accordingly requests that the Commission accept the enclosed tariff revisions in compliance with the Commission's Waiver Order, effective May 1, 2022.

I. Background

In Order No. 676-I, the Commission amended its regulations to incorporate by reference the latest version (Version 003.2) of specified business practice standards that NAESB filed with the Commission on December 8, 2017 and including minor clarifications and updates submitted by NAESB on June 5, 2019 and July 23, 2019. The Version 003.2 NAESB standards include updates to standards that the Commission previously incorporated by reference into its regulations. The Version 003.2 standards build upon the standards included in the WEQ Version 003.1 Standards and include, in their entirety, the modifications submitted to the Commission in WEQ Version 003.1, which were the subject of

an earlier notice of proposed rulemaking.5

The Version 003.2 standards also include updates to NAESB's Smart Grid Standards (WEQ-018 and WEQ-019) that the Commission listed for informational purposes in Part 2 of the Commission's' Regulations, to match the latest iteration of those standards.⁶ Finally, the Commission incorporated by reference the WEQ-022 Electric Industry Registry (EIR) Business Practice Standards, but declined to incorporate by reference in its entirety the WEQ-023 Modeling Business Practice Standards.⁷

Order No. 676-I directed public utilities to revise their Open Access Transmission Tariffs ("OATTs") to incorporate certain NAESB standards by reference.⁸

The Commission initially directed public utilities to submit their Order No. 676-I compliance filings by May 25, 2020, and to make the tariff revisions in those filings using an indeterminant effective date (12/31/9998) for the tariff records.⁹ However, in response to a motion for extension of time, the

Commission extended the date for compliance and waiver filings to July 27, 2021.¹⁰

In addition, on March 3, 2020, the Commission issued a notice explaining that in publishing the final rule, the Federal Register made various formatting and editorial changes to the text of the regulations, 18 C.F.R. §§ 2.27 and 38.1 (2021), where the Commission incorporates by reference NAESB's WEQ Business Practice Standards.¹¹ The Commission stated that the regulatory text included with the Commission's Order No. 676-I, as issued by the Commission, would be revised by the March 3, 2020 notice to reflect the regulatory text as published in the Federal Register.¹²

On July 23, 2021, as amended on October 21, 2021, the CAISO submitted its compliance filing¹³ and a request for waivers¹⁴ in response to the compliance

requirements of Order No. 676-I. The Commission accepted this filing in its Waiver Order on March 7, 2022.¹⁵

The Waiver Order also granted the CAISO's requests for waiver. Specifically, the Commission granted the CAISO's requests for continued waiver of WEQ-002, WEQ-003, and WEQ-013, as well as a renewed partial waiver of WEQ-001 and WEQ-012.¹⁶ The Commission also granted CAISO's request for waiver of the newly adopted Version 003.2 Business Practice Standards requirements related to Open Access Same-Time Information System (OASIS) that are based on the transmission service model embodied in the *pro forma* OATT.¹⁷ Finally, the Commission granted CAISO's request for waiver of the newly adopted Version 003.2 Business Practice Standards in WEQ-006-5 and WEQ-006-9 pertaining to the time monitoring and time error notification, respectively.¹⁸

With respect to the granted waiver of the standards cited above, the Commission directed the CAISO to make a compliance filing, within 30 days of the date of the Order, to revise section 7.3.3 of its tariff to indicate those standards for which the Commission has granted waiver, and for each of those

standards granted waiver, to include a cite to the order granting the waiver requests.¹⁹

II. Proposed Tariff Revisions

Adoption of the NAESB standards set forth in Order No. 676-I does not require any substantive changes or revisions to the existing provisions of the CAISO tariff. Therefore, in accordance with Order No. 676-I, the CAISO previously revised section 7.3.3 of its tariff to incorporate those NAESB standards by reference.

Now, the CAISO has revised tariff section 7.3.3 further to list the Version 003.2 NAESB standards for which the CAISO has been granted a waiver, and citing the Commission's Waiver Order, issued March 7, 2022.
