**Compliance Filing to Implement Metering Rules
Enhancements**

Dear Secretary Bose:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) respectfully submits this filing in compliance with the Commission's directive in its March 31, 2017 letter order issued in this docket.¹ On February 8, 2017, the CAISO proposed a tariff amendment to implement its metering rules enhancement policy initiative. The March 31 order accepted the CAISO's tariff amendment. However, the CAISO regrets that due to administrative oversight, it included the proposed definition of "SQMD Plan" in its exhibits but not in eTariff. The Commission directed the CAISO to make a compliance filing within 30 days from the March 31 order to include the eTariff record of the definition of "SQMD Plan," to correct the missing definition in eTariff.

The CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission accept the eTariff record of the definition of "SQMD Plan," to be effective April 10, 2017, consistent with the Commission's March 31 order.
