

**Comments of Boston Energy Trading and Marketing  
Generator Contingency and Remedial Action Scheme Modeling Draft Final Proposal**

Boston Energy Trading and Marketing (“Boston Energy”) appreciates the opportunity to provide brief comments on the CAISO’s Generator Contingency and Remedial Action Scheme Modeling draft final proposal dated June 30, 2017.

Boston Energy requests the ISO publish the list of generators/load’s that have RAS schemes included in the expanded constraint modeling design. Without such information it will be near impossible for market participants to understand market outcomes and price formation. Further, transparency into which generators have RAS schemes is critical for forward market products such as CRR’s. Failing to release such information would be inconsistent with FERC’s recent efforts to improve transparency on the price formation process through the Uplift Cost Allocation and Transparency in Markets NOPR.
