Scope of the Transmission Development Forum

- The purpose of these meetings is to create a single forum to track the status of transmission network upgrade projects that affect generators and all other transmission projects approved in the CAISO's transmission planning process.
- The purpose of this forum is <u>not</u> to discuss project cost information.

Where to get project cost information

- PG&E Stakeholder Transmission Asset Review (STAR) Process
- SCE Stakeholder Review Process (SRP)
- TO5 Evaluation of SDG&E's Forecast Period Capital Additions (not publicly available)
- AB 970 Reports (note that SCE's SRP includes SCE's AB 970 report information)

Pacific Gas & Electric

- PG&E Stakeholder Transmission Asset Review (STAR) Process Transmission projects only semi-annually until the end of 2023

- Wide cost range of interconnection-related network upgrades in quarterly AB 970 Reports
- After 2023, potentially just AB 970 Reports

Southern California Edison

- Stakeholder Review Process (SRP) both transmission projects over \$1M and interconnection-related network upgrades semi-annually until the end of 2023

• After 2023, potentially just AB 970 Reports

San Diego Gas & Electric

- TO5 Evaluation of SDG&E's Forecast Period Capital Additions

 transmission projects annually. SDG&E's transmission data
 provided pursuant to its TO5 settlement (FERC Docket No.
 ER19-221) is not publicly available.
- Only "interested parties" who have intervened in that FERC Docket and have signed the protective order (i.e., NDA) for that docket have access to the data
- Wide cost range of interconnection-related network
 upgrades in quarterly AB 970 Reports
- After expiration of TO5 formula, AB 970 reports only

Currently, the only long-term source of cost information for all three utilities is the AB 970 Report.
