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Reference: Tariff Amendment to Alter Real-Time Market Bid Generation

On October 11, 2019, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed tariff revisions to modify the real-time market bid generation for Non-Resource-Specific System Resources providing resource adequacy capacity (NRS-RA resources). The tariff revisions provide that CAISO will not submit a generated bid, beyond their day-ahead market award, for NRS-RA resources that fail to meet their bidding obligation in the real-time market, as reflected in the revised sections 40.6.1, 40.6.2, and 40.6.8 of CAISO's tariff. Waiver of the notice requirement pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,<sup>1</sup> and the tariff revisions are accepted, effective October 12, 2019, as requested.<sup>2</sup>

The filing was noticed on October 11, 2019, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before November 1, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are

granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
