Dear Mr. Jaffe:

On October 31, 2008, you submitted, on behalf of the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO), tariff revisions to continue the current Grid Management Charge rate formula until the earlier of January 1, 2010 or the implementation of the CAISO's Market Redesign and Technology Upgrade. Consistent with the CAISO's proposal, you state that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) also proposes to continue use of the current Grid Management Charge rate formula in its Pass-Through Tariff. The CAISO's revised tariff sheet is accepted for filing, effective January 1, 2009, as requested. PG&E's proposal is acknowledged for informational purposes, and no further action is required.

The filing was noticed on November 10, 2008 with comments due on or before November 21, 2008. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 211 and Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.211 and § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the CAISO or PG&E.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Tariffs and Market Development - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
