

Decision on reliability must-run designation for Agnews Power Plant

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Board of Governors Meeting General Session July 15, 2021 Seeking conditional approval to designate the Agnews Power Plant as reliability must-run for November to December 2021 and for 2022:

- Owned by O.L.S. Energy-Agnews, Inc. (28.56 MW)
- Retirement/mothball notice: November 20, 2020.
- Requested retirement/mothball date: November 1, 2021 Denied
- Found to be required to meet the local capacity requirements in the San Jose sub-area of the Bay Area local area.
- No reliability must-run contract will be executed if the resource secures a resource adequacy contract in the meantime, satisfying the reliability need.



Stakeholder engagement:

- By posting the Announced Retirement and Mothball List in November 2020, the ISO has made public the mothball/retirement intention of Agnews Power Plant
- The technical study results were presented to stakeholders:
 - March 11, 2021 stakeholder meeting to present draft 2022 and 2026 local capacity study results
 - April 7, 2021 stakeholder call to present final 2022 and 2026 local capacity study results
 - May 18, 2021 stakeholder call to present potential reliability must-run designation for Agnews Power Plant
- Results have been included in the final 2022 Local Capacity Technical Report, dated April 30, 2021, and filed in the CPUC's Resource Adequacy proceedings:

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Stakeholder feedback

- Several stakeholders have suggested that the resource should be designated as a system need first and instead of as a local need, given current system-wide resource concerns, to shift cost responsibility from the local transmission access charge area to the overall system.
- The ISO does not agree with that approach given the structure of the ISO tariff and that eliminating the local need eventually requires transmission upgrades.



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Management recommends designation of reliability must-run services as set out below:

- Establish must-run contracts for November-December 2021 and for 2022 based on local capacity requirements for the Agnews Power Plant
- Management will report back the results of the reliability must-run contracts later in the year.



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
