On December 18, 2018, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a filing in compliance with the Commission's November 26, 2018 Order.¹ The November 26 Order accepted CAISO's proposal to temporarily extend six of its tariff provisions and associated tariff revisions related to the limited operability of the Aliso Canyon gas storage facility, but rejected CAISO's proposal to temporarily extend the tariff provision regarding gas price scalars, and directed CAISO to remove the gas price scalar proposal in Section 39.7.1.1.1.3(d) from its tariff. CAISO's revisions are in satisfactory compliance, and are accepted for filing effective November 30, 2018, consistent with the November 26 Order.

The filing was noticed on December 18, 2018, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before January 8, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made

by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.
