Dear Secretary Salas:

On December 12, 2003, the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO") submitted, in the captioned docket, its informational filing pursuant to Article IX, Section B of the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission on May 28, 1999, California Independent System Operator Corporation, 87 FERC ¶ 61,250 (1999) ("Stipulation and Agreement"). This provision requires the ISO to provide on a confidential basis to the Commission (i) information regarding the notice from an RMR Unit requesting a change of Condition; (ii) the date the chosen Condition will begin; and (iii) if the change is from Condition 2, the applicable level of Fixed Option Payment. The ISO has accepted the retraction described in the December 30, 2003 notice.
