On December 6, 2018, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a notice of cancellation of the Energy Imbalance Market Implementation Agreement between CAISO and Puget Sound Energy, Inc. The notice of cancellation is accepted, effective February 5, 2019, as requested.¹

Notice of the filing was issued on December 6, 2018, with comments and interventions due on or before December 27, 2018. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made
