On November 13, 2020, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a compliance filing in response to the Commission's July 16, 2020 Order¹ addressing CAISO's Order Nos. 845 and 845-A² compliance filing. The July 2020 Order directed CAISO to submit further revisions to its tariff with respect to the following reforms: Identification and Definition of Contingent Facilities, and Material Modifications and Incorporation of Advanced Technologies. CAISO's revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the July 2020 Order, and are accepted for filing, effective February 20, 2020.³

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
