Dear Ms. Davies:

On December 15, 2009, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted an informational filing indicating that the owner of one or more Reliability Must-Run (RMR) units has requested a change of condition in the units' operating status. The CAISO states that the informational filing is being submitted pursuant to a settlement approved by the Commission in *California Independent System Operator Corporation*, 87 FERC ¶ 61,250 (1999). The CAISO states that the RMR Owner submitted a notice to the CAISO, on November 30, 2009, transferring the condition of one or more units for the 2010 Contract Year. Receipt of the CAISO's informational filing is hereby acknowledged.

This filing was noticed on December 23, 2009, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before January 5, 2010. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
