Dear Mr. Miliauskas:

On August 1, 2008 the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed tariff sheets and revisions to the Transmission Access Charge (TAC) rate spreadsheet in compliance with the Commission's July 2, 2008 order accepting changes to the CAISO's Transmission Control Agreement (TCA).¹ The revised TAC rate spreadsheet and the tariff sheets are accepted for filing, as designated, effective April 23, 2008, in compliance with the Commission's order.

This filing was noticed on August 7, 2008, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before August 22, 2008. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have

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been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the California Independent System Operator Corporation.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
