Dear Mr. Weaver:

On February 8, 2017, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed tariff revisions to provide market participants with additional flexibility in how they submit settlement quality metered data to CAISO for market settlement purposes. CAISO also proposes tariff revisions to include new measures to ensure that scheduling coordinators provide CAISO with accurate settlement quality metered data. CAISO's tariff revisions are accepted for filing, effective April 10, 2017, as requested.

However, CAISO's proposed definition of "SQMD Plan" is missing in the eTariff record. Therefore, CAISO must make a compliance filing, within 30 days of the date of this letter order, to correct the missing definition in eTariff.

The filing was noticed on February 9, 2017, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before March 1, 2017. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in

the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
