Mark Ferron

California ISO Board of Governors

Governor Jerry Brown reappointed Mark Ferron on January 7, 2016 to the California Independent System Operator Corporation Board of Governors. His three-year term will expire on December 31, 2018.

Mr. Ferron, of Mill Valley, served as a member of the California Public Utilities Commission from 2011 to 2014. Before that, he was a partner at the Silicon Valley Social Venture Fund from 2010 to 2014 and held several positions at Deutsche Bank from 1996 to 2009, including that of managing director and chief operating officer at the Global Markets Division in London. He served as vice president at Salomon Brothers from 1994 to 1996 and at Security Pacific (merged with Bank of America in 1992) from 1986 to 1994.

Mr. Ferron holds a bachelor's degree in mathematics from the University of Notre Dame and a master's degree in economics from Stanford University. A well-known advocate for clean energy and clean transportation, he also is on the Board of Trustees of the Rocky Mountain Institute, is on the Public Policy Board of Veloz.org (a nonprofit focused on advancing electric car adoption in California) and is active with a number of environmental and other mission-driven organizations.
