On April 1, 2019, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a filing in compliance with the Commission's February Order.¹ As directed in the February Order, CAISO's revisions change the term "generator output" to "generator maximum capacity," in the definition of generation loss distribution factor. CAISO's revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the February Order, and are accepted for filing, effective March 1, 2019.

The filing was noticed on April 2, 2019, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before April 22, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.
