## **Updates**

### **Bi-Weekly Market Performance Report**

The ISO posted the bi-weekly market performance report for August 17 through August 30, 2022. During this period, markets were generally quiet. The maximum day-ahead cleared demand was 46,660 MW for the two weeks. The Maximum day-ahead DLAP price was \$318.50/MWh. The reasons for the price excursions in the fifteen-minute and five-minute markets are documented.

#### **Review of the Price Correction Report**

During the week of Aug 22-26, 2022, the ISO processed 98 intervals for price correction due to software defects. During the week of Aug 29- Sep 2, 2022, the ISO processed 35 intervals for software defects.

#### **General Questions**

**Q**: When will the ISO discuss the market conditions for the September heatwave? **A**: The ISO will produce a monthly report for September and schedule a call in October.

**Q**: Can you discuss the process for raising the bid cap from \$1000 to \$2000 and whether SIBR will reject bids or cap them if they are submitted over the cap?

A: The ISO calculates the Maximum Import Bid Price during weekdays between 8 am and 9 am where the ISO pulls electric power prices for Mid-C and Palo Verde and uses the equations detailed in Attachment P of the Market Instruments BPM to determine if the MIBP is over \$1000. When the MIBP is over \$1000, the bid cap will be \$2000 for those hours in the day-ahead market that will be run at 10 am. The notification for the bid cap occurs in SIBR around 9 am. Bids that are not in compliance with the bid cap will be rejected and not capped.
