Reference: Revised Market Efficiency Enhancement Agreement

On October 8, 2019, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed an amendment (Third Amendment) to its Market Efficiency Enhancement Agreement (MEEA) with the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD). The Third Amendment revises Section 3.1 of the MEEA to continue the current term structure of multiple two year extensions up to a six year period after the effective date of the Third Amendment. In addition, CAISO updated the contact information in Schedule 4 (Notices) of the MEEA. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,¹ and the Third Amendment and updated contact information is accepted for filing, effective October 17, 2019, as requested.²

This filing was noticed on October 8, 2019, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before October 29, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are

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granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
