On August 19, 2020, California Independent System Operation Corporation (CAISO) filed a certificate of concurrence and tariff record adopting by reference a Large Generator Interconnection Agreement filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company in Docket No. ER20-2624-000. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,¹ and the tariff record is accepted for filing, effective October 7, 2020, as requested.²

This filing was noticed on August 19, 2020, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before September 9, 2020. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
