Weekly Report to FERC - CAISO sends information to FERC; based on thresholds, rates, and exemptions to meet intent of FERC Directives

FERC Determination: If FERC determines persistent underscheduling, FERC could trigger interim charge

Charge Implementation – CAISO implements Interim Scheduling Charge by SC on going forward basis



Proposed Refinements

- CAISO (Not FERC) collects and reviews data
- Bright Line Rule
 - Based on Incidents per month OR
 - Total incidents
- Small Load Exemption Updated
- Forecast Data on OASIS
