- Target a GMC revenue cap at or close to the same level as 2009.



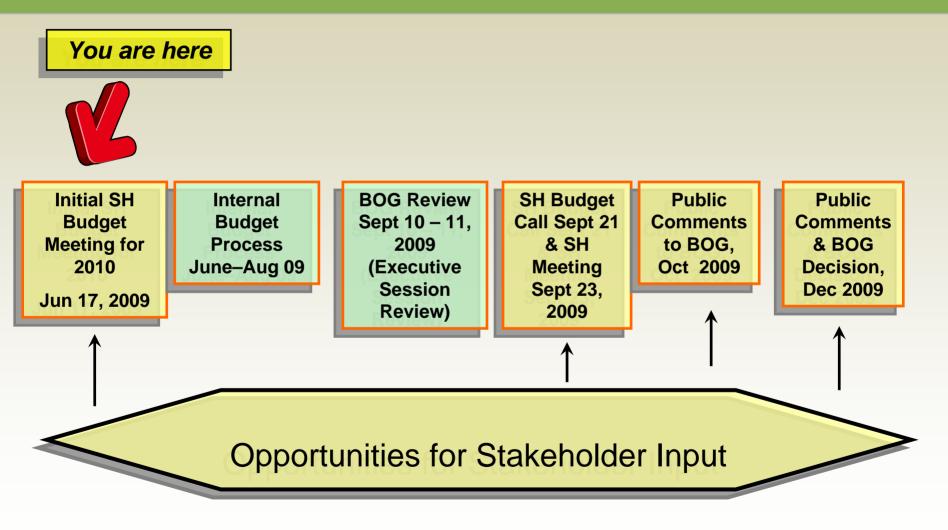

 - Deploy world class recruiting strategies

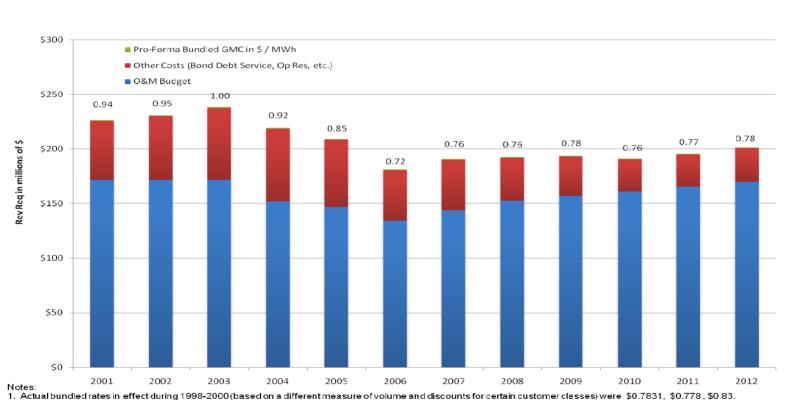


2010 Budget Stakeholder Process

3. Projected revenue requirement and rates are affected by numerous factors including volumes, budget variances, interest rates, etc. Actual amounts may differ.

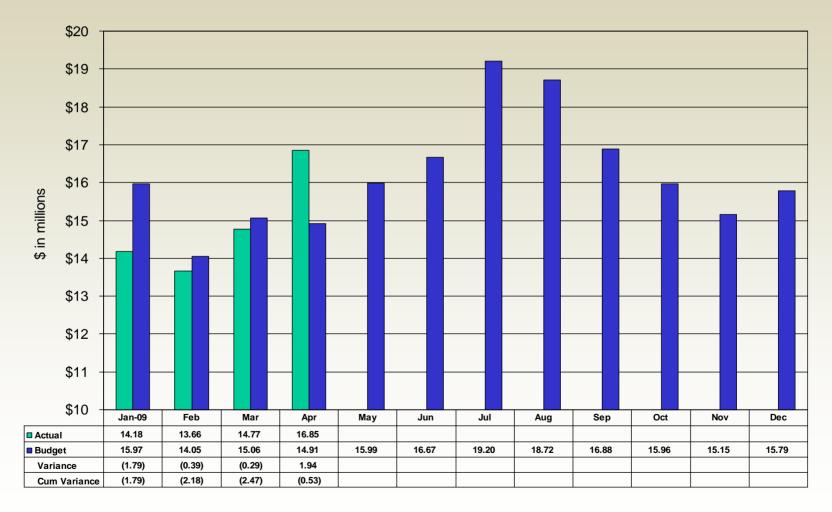


Financial Review (2009 YTD)

- Capital Expenditures



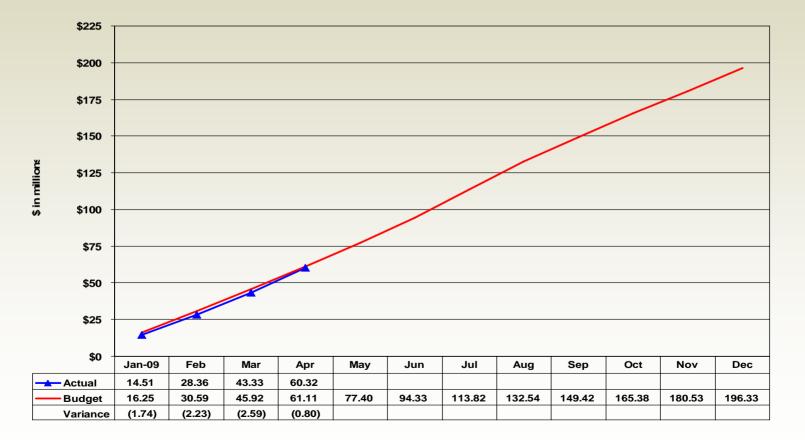
2009 YTD GMC Revenues





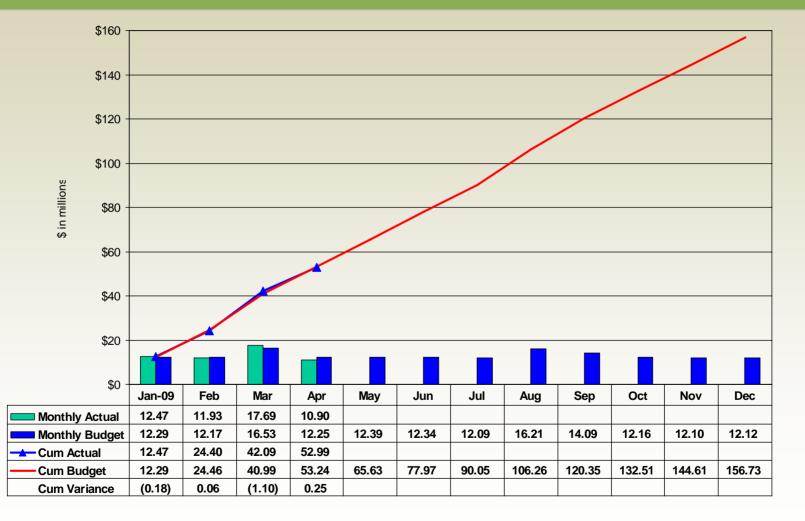
2009 YTD Cumulative Operating Revenues

Revenues = GMC, LGIP, WSCC Security & Other Fees



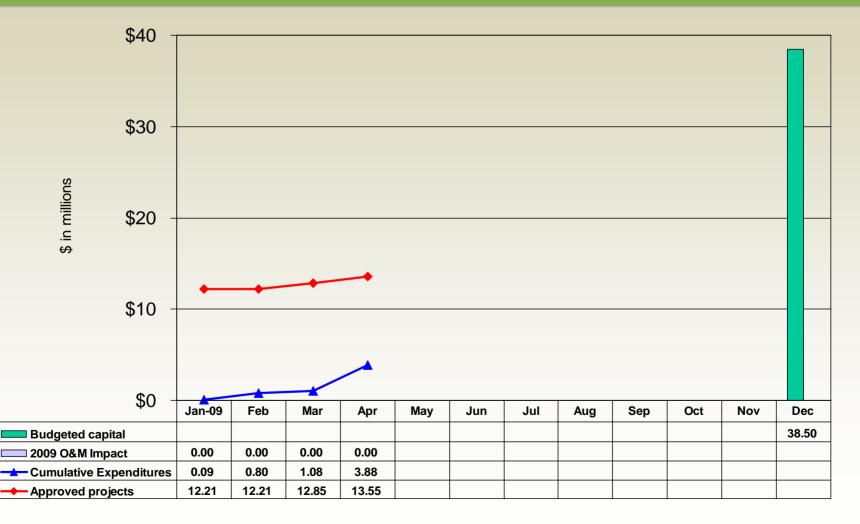


2009 YTD Operating and Maintenance Expenses
