# WHY ARE WE HERE?

For the wheeling-through scheduling priorities, the need arises as supply shortfalls across the western interconnection are contributing to increased dependence on import generation to serve load reliably.

Need: A workable framework for establishing market scheduling priority for wheeling-through the ISO system is a critical issue for external and internal load serving entities.





<u>PRR: 1548</u>

#### NEW PROCESS FOR ESTABLISHING WHEELING THROUGH PRIORITY

- Available Transfer Capability (ATC) is secured in advance on the ISO interties to establish wheeling through priority equal to ISO load.
  - ATC can be reserved in
    - Monthly increments (13-month horizon)
    - Daily increments (7-uay nonzon).
- Wheeling through transactions without secured ATC in advance will have a lower market clearing priority.

### SIBR Example of Export/Import

- There can be a one to many association for Export to Import with a PWT position MW. The Export and Import together per hour in the record are unique.
  - ExportA with ImportB for 45MW
  - ExportA with ImportC for 25MW
  - ExportB with ImportA for 30MW
  - *ExportC* with *ImportB* for 10MW
- There can only be one counter resource per Wheeling Transaction for the trading hour.
- ExportA can use either ImportB or ImportC but not both for a trade hour.

## Scheduling Infrastructure & Business Rules (SIBR) terminology

- The following terms relate to self-schedules submitted in SIBR:
  - PT export [or SS-STD (Self-Schedule Standard) in SIBR UI]:
    - Self-schedule with designated resource
  - LPT export [or SS-LPT in SIBR UI]:
    - Self-schedule with no identified resource
  - PT wheel:
    - Self-scheduled wheel that meets tariff criteria for high priority wheeling through transaction
- For a refresher, please refer to the <u>Transmission Service and Market Scheduling Priorities Phase</u> <u>1 (TSMSP1) training</u>

Wheels in SIBR are a bit more complex. The wheel will indicate **SS-STD** from the import side and could be **SS-STD** or **SS-LPT** from the export side. Note: If the wheel is on a registered intertie, the export cannot name a supporting resource.



SIBR
