

September 1st 2022 Exceptional Dispatch Capacity Procurement Mechanism Designations Report

Designations Summary:

On September 1, 2022, the California ISO issued an Exceptional Dispatch Capacity Procurement Mechanism (CPM) designation to address a system reliability need to the resources listed below. The quantity of the designation was 100.77 megawatts (MW).

Reason for CPM Exceptional Dispatch Designations:

The ISO issued Exceptional Dispatch CPM designations to the resources listed above to address an Exceptional Dispatch CPM System Reliability Need. The CAISO Exceptionally Dispatched the specified quantities from these units because that energy was needed to maintain system reliability in light of the record-breaking heat wave across California and other western states in combination with other operating factors. The resources listed above responded to the Exceptional Dispatch and at least part of the capacity that responded was not Resource Adequacy capacity. The CPM term for this resource is 30 days, as provided under the tariff, subject to adjustment and the payment provisions in Section 43A of the ISO tariff.
