Dear Secretary Bose:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (“ISO”) hereby submits for filing a Certificate of Concurrence with respect to a Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (“LGIA”) submitted by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) on September 19, 2012 in Docket No. ER12-5658-000, which PG&E designated as Service Agreement No. 210 under PG&E FERC Electric Tariff Volume No. 5.¹

I. Overview and Designated Filer

The LGIA, designated as Service Agreement No. 210 under PG&E FERC Electric Tariff Volume No. 5, is a three-party generator interconnection agreement among PG&E, the ISO, and the Tri-Dam Project, a joint venture of the South San Joaquin Irrigation District and the Oakdale Irrigation District (“Tri-Dam Project”), regarding the Tulloch Powerhouse.

PG&E serves as the “designated filer” as to the LGIA pursuant to the Joint Tariff Filing procedures outlined in Order No. 714.² Also, as shown in concurrence tariff records for the LGIA that are attached to the instant filing, the LGIA is designated as Service Agreement No. 2668 under the ISO tariff.

II. Proposed Effective Date and General Request for Waivers

The ISO respectfully requests any waivers of the Commission’s filing regulations necessary to establish an effective date of March 31, 2012 for its Certificate of Concurrence, consistent with the March 31 effective date that PG&E requested for the LGIA in its September 19 filing. To the extent that the enclosed materials and information do not meet the detailed filing requirements of the Commission’s regulations, the ISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant any necessary waivers.
