**STATUS REPORT OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM
OPERATOR CORPORATION ON THE RECONCILIATION OF
SETTLEMENT INFORMATION WITH THE CALIFORNIA POWER
EXCHANGE**

I. INTRODUCTION

On March 18, 2002, the Presiding Judge in this proceeding issued an Order Requiring Status Reports and Convening Prehearing Conference.” Therein, the Presiding Judge ordered the California Independent System Operator Corporation (“ISO”) to file a status report by March 20, 2002 addressing the issue of data discrepancies raised by the California Power Exchange Corporation (“PX”) in a letter dated March 15, 2002, pertaining to the information the ISO had filed on March 1, 2002 as part of the testimony and exhibits of Mr. Spence Gerber.

II. STATUS REPORT

Once the Presiding Judge's order was received, the ISO immediately contacted PX staff to determine what information was required to effect the reconciliation. This was done on March 18th, the same day the order was issued. The ISO has drafted the attached response to the specific questions posed by the PX. A follow-up conference call between the ISO and the PX is to be held later this week. The ISO stands ready to work with the PX and all market participants to fully explain the methods by which it developed the settlement information that was a part of its March 1st filing. Attached to this report is the following:

- (1) The original email text sent from Larry Conn of the California Power Exchange to the ISO entitled Basic Discrepancies.
- (2) The spreadsheet entitled ISO-30 Reconciliation that was attached to the aforementioned mentioned email.
- (3) The ISO's responses to the questions presented by Larry Conn of the California Power Exchange in the email entitled Basic Discrepancies.
