

# Setting the Net Export Transfer Constraint

Extended day-ahead market ISO balancing authority area participation rules

#### Background


- Higher confidence factor (CF) enables:
  - a. More non-RSE eligible supply to increase NETC
  - b. Higher volume of CISO BAA supply offers
  - c. Potentially higher EDAM revenues through transfers throughout year
- Lower CF:
  - a. More domestic supply retained in CISO BAA on DA basis, enhancing reliability within CISO BAA only
  - b. Lower revenues from EDAM transactions across the entire year
- Historical data useful, but preference to ease in to EDAM

### Cal Advocates' Proposal

- Calculate the CF by iteratively bridging the gap between historical performance and starting point of zero
- Average Year<sub>n-1</sub> observed historical import performance and Year<sub>n-1</sub> CF
- Over time the CF would converge on observed historical import performance
- Revisited annually by CISO BAA stakeholders
- Interim solution until EDAM well-established

## Example

Year <sub>n</sub>	Year <sub>n-1</sub> CF	Year <sub>n-1</sub> Observed historical import performance	Calculation	CF for Year <sub>n</sub>
1	0	0.98	(0 + 0.98) / 2	0.49
2	0.49	0.98	(0.49 + 0.98) / 2	0.74
3	0.74	0.98	(0.74 + 0.98) / 2	0.86
4	0.86	0.80	(0.86 + 0.80) / 2	0.83



### Cal Advocates' Proposal

#### **Advantages**

- Balanced and predictable
- Achieving maximum EDAM benefits for CA ratepayers requires building trust with other entities
- Incentives for EDAM Market Operator and CISO BAA aligned to avoid load shed

#### Potential disadvantages can be mitigated

 Expects reciprocal treatment by other BAAs to setting their own NETCs; if other BAAs set excessively conservative NETC, CISO BAA should revise

#### Remaining Questions

- Temporal granularity of the CF: Hourly/Monthly/Yearly?
  - Suggest month-hour (like Slice of Day), monthly at a minimum
- How many years of prior performance for setting initial year observed historical import performance?
  - Suggest three to five years
- How to account for very-recent trends?
  - Consider emergency option to CISO BAA to reduce CF, e.g. SCE and CalCCA comments on stressed conditions
