## Draft Final Updates

- Percentage allocations and fees remain the same as in the draft.
- Provides additional information on the benefits of EDAM transitional load ramp-in model in response to stakeholder comments.
- Propose to eliminate the tariff language in Appendix F - Rate Schedules, Schedule 1 - Grid Management Charge, Part E – System Operations Charge Exemption for Certain Long-Term Power Supply Contracts as there are no longer any active power supply contracts that are eligible for the exemption.
