### New process for establishing wheeling through priority starting for June 2024 and beyond

- On October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023, FERC approved a new process for establishing market clearing priority for wheeling through transactions.
  - Effective June 1, 2024.
- Under the new process, Available Transfer Capability (ATC) is secured in advance on the ISO interties to establish wheeling through priority equal to ISO load.
  - ATC can be reserved in Monthly increments (13-month horizon) or Daily increments (7-day horizon).
- Wheeling through transactions without secured ATC in advance will have a lower market clearing priority.



#### Implementation plan and timelines overview

- Implementation of wheeling through priority process supports load service planning for Summer 2024.
- ISO will begin implementation through <u>manual</u> processes starting mid-January.
  - Publication of Monthly ATC values for June 2024 and beyond, and opening reservation window in January.
- New automation functionality will be available in April to support further reservation of Monthly and Daily ATC in June and beyond.

### Interim wheeling through priorities framework remains in effect through May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024

- The "interim" process for establishing wheeling through priority can continue to be utilized when seeking to establish priority for periods ahead of May 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - Demonstration of the following requirements at least
    45-days in advance of a month:
    - Firm power supply contract
    - Firm transmission deliverability to the ISO system
- New framework for establishing wheeling through priority based on ATC reservation in advance is effective on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.



# January 2024 manual implementation activities

### The ISO will manually calculate and post Monthly ATC values across a 13-month horizon

- The ISO is in the process of calculating Monthly ATC values for June 2024 to January 2025 (13-month horizon).
- To facilitate the manual calculation of ATC, the ISO has requested historical non-RA contracted import data from ISO load serving entities.
  - Data submitted by January 8<sup>th</sup>
- The ATC values for select interties will be posted by January 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - On the <u>reliability requirements webpage</u>.



### Manual ATC calculation on interties previously supporting requests for wheeling through priority

- During the period that the manual process is in effect, the ISO will calculate ATC on select interties:
  - CFEROA La Rosita Tie
  - CFETIJ Tijuana Tie
  - CTW230 Cottonwood 230
  - MALIN500 Malin 500kV
  - MIR2 Mirage/Coachella 230
  - NOB Nevada/Oregon Border
  - SYLMAR Sylmar AC
  - TESLA230 Tracey/Tesla 1 and 2
  - TRCYCOTP Tracy 500 intertie with BANC
  - TRCYPGAE Tracy 500 intertie with BANC



### Request window opens on January 18 to support requests for Monthly wheeling through priority

- The ISO will open the request window consistent with section 23 of the tariff to support submission of requests for Monthly ATC.
- Request window opens January 18<sup>th</sup> through January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
- Requests for Monthly ATC cover the following period:
  - June 2024 through January 2025
- Results will be communicated to scheduling coordinators submitting requests within three (3) business days of window closing.

### Requests for Monthly ATC will be submitted via the CIDI tool

- Requests for ATC will be submitted during the reservation window through the CIDI functionality with the following requested information:
  - MW quantity of the request
  - Intertie point of receipt and export point of delivery
  - Duration (start and stop date) in months
  - Underlying duration/hours of the supply contract supporting the request
  - Whether willing to accept partial service
  - Attestation to the accuracy of information submitted
- The ISO will post a template for submission of the information on the Reliability Requirements page ahead of the request window.

## Requests will be manually processed until automated functionality becomes available in April 2024

- The ISO will manually process requests for Monthly ATC during several months leading up to availability of automation.
- Request windows open for the upcoming months:

January: 1/18 – 1/31

– February: 2/18 – 3/2

- March: 3/19 - 4/1

 The ISO will manually process requests for Monthly ATC, competing requests based on underlying duration of supply contract, consistent with section 23 of the tariff.

### BPM updates to reflect the manual process implementation


- The ISO will publish a revised draft version of the *Market Operations BPM* which will capture:
  - Description of processes associated with ATC calculation and submission of information
  - Submission process for requests for Monthly ATC during the request windows
- The BPM will be further revised and updated once the automated functionality becomes available to describe the associated processes.
