## FERC MATTERS (1)

- **MRTU (ER02-1656)**
  - MRTU filing on May 13 seeking approval for
    - Clearing of demand bids at LAP level
    - Revised HASP proposal
    - Market Power Mitigation package
  - Sellers' Choice Proceeding (ER04-108)
    - Presiding ALJ certifies Sempra- CERS and Calpine-CERS uncontested conditional settlements
- **Request for Comments on Long Term Transmission Rights (AD05-7)**
  - Comments due June 27



# CALIFORNIA ISO

## FERC MATTERS (2)

California Independent  
System Operator

- **Amendments 66 and 69 (ER05-718) Inter-tie Settlements**
  - **On May 9, CAISO filed**
    - Clarification that “pay as bid” can serve as longer-term option
    - Rehearing that interim solution would sunset on 9/30
    - Plan for developing longer-term solution
  - **On May 20, FERC issued an order**
    - Granting clarification
    - Denying rehearing
    - Accepting Amendment No. 69
- **Petition for Declaratory Order (EL05-114)**
  - **Filed on May 13 seeking order that new governance structure acceptable**



## FERC MATTERS (3)

- **NOPR re ISO/RTO Cost Reporting (RM04-12)**
  - On June 2, FERC issued a NOPR proposing changes to the Uniform System of Accounts
  - Comments due in 60 days
- **NOPR re NAESB standards (RM05-5)**
  - On May 9, FERC issued NOPR proposing to incorporate technical standards developed by the North American Energy Standard Board
  - Comments due July 1, 2005



## FERC MATTERS (4)

- **Southwest Powerlink (SWPL) Agreements (ER05-1013)**
  - On May 24, CAISO filed Operations Agreement with SDG&E that effectuates settlement agreement
- **NOPR re Intermittent Resources (RM05-10)**
  - Proposes special imbalance energy service for intermittent resources
  - On May 26, CAISO filed comments explaining that CAISO's PIRP meets NOPR objective and more
- **Final Rule on Large Winter Generators (RM05-4)**
  - On May 25, FERC issued final rule on technical requirements for Wind Generators



## FERC MATTERS (5)

- **Final Rule on Small Generation (RM02-12)**
  - On May 12, FERC issued order 2006 specifying interconnection procedures for generating units no larger than 20 MW subject to FERC jurisdiction
- **Notice of Inquiry re calculation of ATC (RM05-17)**
  - On May 27, FERC issued a notice of inquiry regarding transmission providers' calculation of "available transfer capability"
  - Comments due in 60-days



## CPUC MATTERS (1)

- **SDG&E Application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Construct Otay Mesa Transmission Line (A.04-03-008)**
  - On May 2, 2005, the CPUC issued a proposed decision granting the amended application of SD&GE for a CPCN to construct 573 MW Otay Mesa Generation Project to meet SDG&E's reliability needs
  - The CAISO filed supporting testimony consistent with the May 6, approval by the CAISO BOG
