<u>About the ISO</u> This menu selection provides general information about the mission and infrastructure of the Cal-ISO. Look for answers to frequently asked questions about the ISO, control room facts and a transmission grid map, an organizational chart and bios of Cal-ISO officers.

**ISO News** This is the place to find news releases, public information officers for market participants, and public notices.

<u>The New Marketplace</u> Two primers on the restructured electricity marketplace are available here: one is a visual journey through the industry; the second provides a text narration.

<u>Market Participants</u> Industry watchers and participants will find this menu offering of continual use as it contains tariffs governing the ISO's operation, protocols and draft agreements for market participants, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission filings and rulings, the Open Access Same-Time Information System (OASIS), which supplies public market information, a list of scheduling coordinator applications, and a link to the Scheduling Coordinators User Group website.
