The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO")<sup>1</sup> respectfully submits six copies of the present filing in compliance with the Commission's March 22, 2005 order in Docket Nos. ER03-218-005, *et al.*, 110 FERC ¶ 61,297 ("March 22 Order"), concerning the Transmission Control Agreement between the ISO and Participating Transmission Owners ("TCA").

In the March 22 Order, the Commission noted that the ISO did not object to amending Section 3.4.8 of the TCA to change the phrase "facilities, recognizing Entitlements, of a non-public utility" to "any affected transmission lines, associated facilities, or Entitlements," and directed the ISO to so amend the TCA. March 22 Order at PP 8, 10. The ISO has modified Section 3.4.8 of the TCA to comply with this directive.

The change to the TCA described above is shown in the revised sheet provided in Attachment A to the present filing, and is shown in black-line format in Attachment B. Additionally, the ISO submits, in Attachment C, a form notice of filing suitable for publication in the Federal Register, along with a computer diskette containing the notice of filing.

Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein are defined in the Master Definitions Supplement, ISO Tariff Appendix A., as filed August 15, 1997, and subsequently revised.






