Dear Mr. Anders:

On September 30, 2011, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a Pseudo Participating Generator Agreement (Pseudo PGA) with Mesquite Solar 1, LLC (Mesquite Solar) to establish a pseudo-tie of the Mesquite Solar generating facility, which is physically located in the Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District balancing authority area, to the CAISO balancing authority area. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,¹ and the Pseudo PGA is accepted, effective November 1, 2011, as requested.

This filing was noticed on October 3, 2011, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before October 21, 2011. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
