On March 7, 2012, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted for filing revised tariff records to specify that the effective date of its tariff provisions for regulation energy management and non-generator resource functionality is extended from April 10, 2012 until November 27, 2012, in order to provide additional time to complete software testing. The revised tariff records are accepted, effective April 10, 2012.

Notice of filing was issued on March 8, 2012, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before March 28, 2012. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
