Today, the California Energy Commission unanimously approved the license amendment for Huntington Beach Units 3 and 4 to synchronous condensers.

I then filed a letter with FERC that supports the California Independent System Operator's (CAISO) FERC filing in ER13-3351 to operate Huntington Beach Units 3 and 4 as synchronous condensers under a reliability must-run contract. The same letter was submitted under Declaratory Order EL13-21-000 stating that consent from BE CA LLC and JP Morgan Ventures Energy Corporation is not needed to proceed with the RMR contract.
