The ISO will discuss a new spreadsheet that relates to the Generator Management BPM proposed changes submitted in PRR 1056. The spreadsheet will provide stakeholders with information regarding notification requests to change a resource status from active to retired, mothballed, or otherwise unavailable to the grid. The document will contain the status of the ISO grid reliability review, deliverability retention status and major milestones for maintaining deliverability for the retired/mothballed resources.
