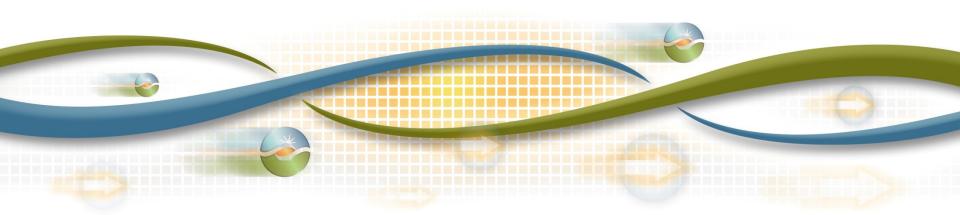



# **Upcoming Stakeholder Initiatives**

- Greenhouse Gas Compliance Starts February 2016
- Metering Rules Update Starts February 2016
- Full Network Model Enhancements Starts July 2016

SB 350 requires the ISO to prepare proposed governance modifications and to study impacts to a regional market.

Studies will determine the overall benefits to ratepayers including:

- The creation and retention of jobs and other benefits to the California economy
- Environmental impacts in California and elsewhere
- Impacts in disadvantaged communities
- Emissions of greenhouse gases and other air pollutants
- Reliability and integration of renewable energy resources.

Proposed governance modifications and results of studies will be presented at public workshop with CPUC, CEC and CARB


