# CRR 1b Post Implementation Update (cont.)

Summary of change:

- **Issue:** CRR options are not receiving adequate payment for their CRR. This issues is due to the netting of notional values across time intervals when the option is in the counter flow vs. flow direction. The CRR option should receive a payment in the flow direction and not receive a payment when the sink exceeds the source.
- **Solution:** This enhancement will run prior to the CRR1B calculation process. The source and sink MCCs shall be compared for each option CRR and each hour. If the value of sink MCC source MCC is positive, then the CRR shall be included in the CRR1B calculations for that hour. If the value is zero or negative, then the CRR shall not be included. This shall be an hour by hour comparison. A possible outcome is that an option CRR is considered in CRR1B for some hours but not all hours.
  - This change will be effective 1/1/2019

# Spring 2020 - Release Scope and Milestones

Spring 2020 Settlement Release

  - **Project:** Black start system restoration phase 2 tech docs posted on 2/10
  - **Production Variances:** RC enhancement
- 1<sup>st</sup> draft configuration output file + release component summary published on 2/25
  - Two files, 1 Market and 1 RC
- $2^{nd}$  draft configuration output files (if needed) = posting 3/19
- Pre-prod configuration output files and Design Standard updates = posting 4/22
- Production deployment planned for **4/29**



# PRR and BPM Update

- **PRR 1227** for FERC 841 settlement effective date change and **PRR 1223** for congestion revenue rights transparency enhancement; recommendation comment period will close 3/17/2020
- **PRR 1233** with regard to settlement and invoicing impacts from Black start system restoration phase 2 initiative and **PRR 1234** is to correct settlement of the reliability coordinator minimum charge for entities onboarding outside of April 1 timeline and initial comment period will close 3/17/2020
