The ISO will disable TLS 1.0 and 1.1 in accordance with industry best practices for security and data integrity

TLS 1.0 and 1.1 disabled in MAP-Stage on February 26

Scheduled date to disable TLS 1.0 and 1.1 in production: April 23

Participants should be nearing the end of their testing

Project Info	Details	
Application Software Changes	 Transition to web-based user interface to eliminate the need to install thick client. Transition ADS provisioning to the Access and Identity Management (AIM) application including Resource Level Access Controls (RACL) access Display 15 minute schedules, 5 & 15-minute Flex Ramp awards (FRU/FRD) in ADS GUI and will be available via B2B. Details will be communicated in BRS. Various enhancements (mostly related to user interface) adding content per Operation's request.


CAISO proposes to keep in ADS 90 days worth of data. Is there a need for any historical data to be kept beyond the 90 day period?
