Disabling TLS 1.0 and 1.1

The ISO will disable TLS 1.0 and 1.1 in accordance with industry best practices for security and data integrity

TLS 1.0 and 1.1 disabled in MAP-Stage on February 26

Scheduled date to disable TLS 1.0 and 1.1 in production: April 23

Participants should be nearing the end of their testing

The ADS 6.1.0.0 client is required for TLS 1.2: https://mpp.caiso.com/ads_install

Both v6 and v7 ADS APIs support TLS 1.2


