**SUPPLEMENTAL ANSWER OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM
OPERATOR CORPORATION TO MOTION TO DISMISS SHOW CAUSE
PROCEEDING, WITHDRAWING OPPOSITION TO DISMISSAL**

On September 30, 2003, the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO") filed its Answer in opposition to the Motion To Dismiss Show Cause Proceeding ("Motion") filed by Commission Trial Staff ("Staff") in this docket on August 28, 2003. Since filing that Answer, counsel for the CAISO has consulted with Staff and counsel for Azusa concerning the materials reviewed by Staff prior to its filing of the Motion. Based on these discussions and other considerations, including the fact that no other intervenor with access to the materials opposed the Motion, and in the interest of the most efficient and productive deployment of CAISO resources in these proceedings, the CAISO withdraws its opposition to the Motion insofar as the Motion requests that the Commission relieve Azusa of the obligation to respond further on the issue of Paper Trading.
