SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ADDRESSING ORAL ARGUMENT

(Issued April 6, 2009)

1. This Order sets out procedures for the oral argument scheduled for April 16, 2009, and addresses the scope of that argument.
2. Only participants that have filed briefs may present arguments. The order of argument will be as follows:

Green Borders Geothermal, LLC
Southern California Edison Company (SCE)
California Independent System Operator Corporation
Commission Trial Staff
3. Green Borders will have 30 minutes to make a presentation and answer questions, and may reserve part of that time for rebuttal. The remaining participants will each have 20 minutes to make presentations and answer questions. Further rebuttal will be at the Presiding Judge's discretion.
4. The principal purpose of the argument is to enable the Presiding Judge to question the participants regarding their positions, and to allow the participants to respond to arguments contained in the reply briefs.
5. The participants should be prepared to discuss all issues raised in the briefs. In particular, the participants should be prepared to discuss the rule that requires SCE and/or CAISO to obtain Oxbow Corporation's consent prior to opening Breaker Bay # 8 at SCE's Control 115 kV Substation during an N-1 event. The participants should also be prepared to discuss the extent to which the definitions and other provisions of the Standard Large Generator Interconnection Procedures and the Standard Large Generator Interconnection Agreement contained in

Appendix C to Order No. 2003¹ should govern classification of the facilities in this case.
