On March 30, 2011, you submitted for filing a compliance filing in response to the Commission's February 28, 2011 order on tariff revisions. In CAISO's compliance filing, it has attached a transmittal letter and copies of clean and marked tariff sections, but has not filed any tariff revisions into the Commission's electronic tariff system (eTariff). Since CAISO has not submitted revised tariff sections into our eTariff portal, there are no tariff sections before the Commission for it to consider. Accordingly, the CAISO's March 30, 2011 filing in Docket No. ER11-2574-001 is rejected. CAISO must re-file its compliance revisions in the Commission's eTariff portal within ten days of the date of this letter order.
