DECLARATION OF DEBORAH A. LE VINE ON BEHALF OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION

- My name is Deborah A. Le Vine and I am the Director of Contracts for the California Independent System Operator (ISO). My business address is 151 Blue Ravine Road, Folsom, California 95630.
- 2. As the Director of Contracts, I am responsible for negotiation and administration of all pro forma agreements executed by Market Participants. In addition, since October 1998, I have been the project leader for the ISO's development of a new transmission Access Charge which was filed as Amendment No. 27 to the ISO Tariff.
- 3. I provide this affidavit to substantiate the information included in the ISO's filing of June 13, 2001 in its Request for Rehearing in Docket No. EL00-111.
- 4. In the course of my duties at the ISO, I prepared the memorandum to the ISO Governing Board dated March 9, 2000 that described the proposed transmission

Access Charge filing. The memorandum prepared for the ISO Governing Board and the attached tariff language, which has been publicly posted on the ISO Home Page since March 2000, makes clear that Section 11.2.9.1 establishes only an annual cap which can be modified at the discretion of the ISO Governing Board.

5. Additionally, as project leader for the transmission Access Charge, I know that Southern Cities and Vernon had representatives on the transmission Access Charge Working Group that received various versions of the draft ISO Tariff language directly, including a copy of the final Board memorandum, including the attached tariff proposal.
