

# GENERAL SESSION MINUTES AUDIT COMMITTEE MEETING December 12-13, 2018 ISO Headquarters Folsom, California

### **DECISION ON GENERAL SESSION MINUTES**

Governor Olsen moved for approval of the Audit Committee's general session minutes for the May 16, 2018 meeting. The motion was seconded by Governor Ferron and approved 2-0.

## ACCEPTANCE OF OPERATIONS AUDIT

Roger Mills, on behalf of PricewaterhouseCoopers, provided the Audit Committee with an overview of the scope of the operations audit. Mr. Mills described how PwC's examination was limited to checking that the selected real-time network measurement data and real-time balancing authority data elements were submitted by the ISO. He stated that PwC issued an unqualified audit opinion and also noted that PwC did not identify any compliance deviations. Brief discussion followed regarding the operations



assessment periods and Mr. Mills confirmed these were sufficient samplings for the audit.

### Motion

Moved, that the Audit Committee of the ISO Board of Governors accepts the audit opinion issued on December 6, 2018 by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLC for the testing of specified control room operational processes for 2018, as attached to the memorandum dated December 6, 2018.
