On June 30, 2015, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted the Second Amended and Restated Operating Agreement (Amended Agreement) with the City and County of San Francisco. Waiver of the Commission's prior notice requirements pursuant to Section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,<sup>1</sup> and the Amended Agreement is accepted for filing, effective July 1, 2015, as requested, subject to the outcome of the consolidated proceeding in Docket No. EL15-3-000, *et al.*<sup>2</sup>

This filing was noticed on July 1, 2015, with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before July 21, 2015. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
