Dear Mr. Kunselman:

On June 19, 2014, you filed on behalf of California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) revisions to CAISO's Generator Interconnection and Deliverability Allocation Procedures (GIDAP). You state that the amendment will allow for adjustments to interconnection customers' maximum cost responsibility for network upgrade costs and financial security posting based on the results of the annual reassessment of the interconnection base case data the CAISO performs pursuant to the existing GIDAP. CAISO's amendment is accepted for filing, effective September 1, 2014, as requested.

The filing was noticed on June 19, 2014 with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before July 10, 2014. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in

the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
