

These documents comprise the FERC Electric Tariff, Original Volume Nos. I through III, of the California Independent System Operator Corporation, as approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission as of February 15, 2000. These documents also incorporate the following revisions to the ISO Tariff which have been filed with the Commission in compliance with various FERC orders but which the Commission has not acted on as of February 15, 2000.

- Amendment No. 22 compliance filing, submitted in Docket No. ER99-4545 on December 22, 1999 to comply with the Commission's November 24, 1999 order, 89 FERC ¶ 61,229;
- Amendment No. 23 compliance filing, submitted in Docket No. ER00-555 on February 7, 2000 to comply with the Commission's January 7, 2000 order, 90 FERC ¶ 61,006; and
- Compliance filing concerning the ISO's "buy-back" provisions accepted in the Commission's order on Amendment No. 14, submitted in Docket No. ER98-2843 on February 14, 2000 to comply with the Commission's January 14, 2000 order granting rehearing and clarification in part, 90 FERC ¶ 61,036.

These documents do *not* incorporate the following proposed revisions to the ISO Tariff which the Commission has not acted on as of February 15, 2000:

- Amendment No. 25, submitted in Docket No. ER00-1239 on January 27, 2000; and
- Amendment No. 26, submitted in Docket No. ER00-1365 on January 28, 2000.

These documents also do not incorporate the revisions to the ISO Tariff proposed in Amendment No. 24. The ISO filed a notice of withdrawal concerning those proposed revisions in Docket No. ER00-866 on February 4, 2000.

A number of the Tariff revisions proposed in Amendment Nos. 13, 14, 17, and 22 were approved by the Commission to go into effect a certain number of days after the issuance of notices to Market Participants by the ISO. The ISO has issued the following market notices with respect to these Tariff amendments:

- Notices regarding implementation of TO Debits and Negative Pricing for Supplemental Energy, issued on March 9 and 16, 1999, and filed in Docket No. ER99-896 (Amendment No. 13);
- Notice regarding implementation of numerous Ancillary Services redesign elements, including Rational Buyer, Effective Price for Uninstructed Deviations, Use of Replacement Reserves, Separate Pricing of Regulation Up and Regulation Down, and Billing Based on Metered Demand, issued on

August 10, 1999 and filed in Docket No. ER99-1971 (Amendment Nos. 13 and 14);

- Notice regarding implementation of Inter-Scheduling Coordinator Trades of Ancillary Services, issued on September 8, 1999 and filed in Docket No. ER99-1971 (Amendment No. 14);
- Notice regarding implementation of Payment Calendar changes, issued on September 24, 1999 and filed in Docket No. ER99-3289 (Amendment No. 17);
- Notice regarding implementation of Ability to File Disputes of Incremental Changes on Final Settlement Statements, issued on December 3, 1999 and filed in Docket No. ER99-4545 (Amendment No. 22); and
- Notice regarding implementation of Tariff revisions related to the implementation of Firm Transmission Right and modified Existing Transmission Contract scheduling templates, the creation of a new Congestion Management Zone, and implementation of a new methodology for allocating Transmission Losses to Utility Distribution Companies, issued on January 24, 2000 and filed in Docket No. ER99-4545 (Amendment No. 22).

In addition, the ISO notes that it submitted Amendment No. 15 to become effective upon approval of a settlement filed in Docket Nos. ER98-441 *et al.* on April 2, 1999. That settlement was approved by an order issued in those dockets on May 28, 1999, and Amendment No. 15 was accepted in a letter order issued in Docket No. ER99-2407 on May 28, 1999.
